**Contract award to Norwegian Special Mission
from
The Mexican Ministry of Communication and Transport**

2nd May 2005 the Mexican Ministry of Communication and Transport (SCT) awarded this important aviation related contract to the Oslo based company, Norwegian Special Mission AS (NSM).

Direccion General De Aeronautica Civil which is the end user has set the requirements for the scope of this project for modernization and upgrade of one of their Cessna Citation 500 with Navaid's Flight Inspection System on board.

NSM was awarded the contract after participating in a international public tender announced by SCT early spring 2005. All major Flight Inspection Systems Manufacturers world wide was invited to present their proposals. From the bids presented, SCT evaluated NSM to have the best and most cost effective solution for the DGAC.

The scope of work includes a major upgrade of the model 2301 Flight Inspection System, manufactured by the USA based company A.S.I. Major refurbishment of the aircraft FIS antennas and system installation will also be performed under this contract with NSM.

This contract demonstrated the efficiency and flexibility of the NSM computer modules and Software where a completely manual and analogue system efficiently can be converted to a modern, advanced Fully Automatic Flight Inspection System.
