



NORWEGIAN SPECIAL MISSION MAKES HISTORY

NSM is awarded the world largest single contract for delivery of Navais Flight Inspection Systems. 4 dual console UNIFIS 3000 - Fully Automatic Navais Flight Inspection Systems. To be installed and used in 5 EC95 aircraft operated by the Brazilian Air Force.

It is therefore with great pride, respect and responsibility that I can announce that we have reached an agreement to deliver 4 more complex UNIFIS 3000 Flight Inspection Systems to the Brazilian Air Force.

After the successful replacement of their flight inspection systems in their 5 EC95 aircraft, the Brazilian Air Force will now replace their remaining Navais Flight Inspection Systems fleet. This fleet is installed in four Hawker 800XP aircraft, with the Brazilian Air Force designation EU-93A.

The Brazilian Air Force flight inspection group has many challenges. With the rapid growing requirement of new CNS elements to be implemented into the ATM structure in such a vast country, the need for a modern, effective and trustworthy flight inspection system fleet becomes a must.

Brazil is in the process of implementing complex ATM structures including ADS-B, GBAS, Controller Pilot Data Link Communication (CPDLC), D-ATIS, D-CL and ADS-C over both VHF-Data Link mode 2 and SATCOM. The new UNIFIS 3000 systems will support the implementation of and take part in the approval of these new ATM systems in Brazil.

The Brazilian Air Force, NSM and our partners achieves successful completion of this complex program of 4 UNIFIS 3000 and installation of the systems into the 5 aircraft.

The UNIFIS 3000 systems will be installed in the existing EU-93A aircraft, providing a new generation of flight inspection functionality for the organization. At the same time, a considerable modification and upgrade of the cockpit will prepare the fleet for the challenges ahead.

Several local companies will contribute significantly to the contract, transferring technology and knowledge to Brazil in this very specialized field.
